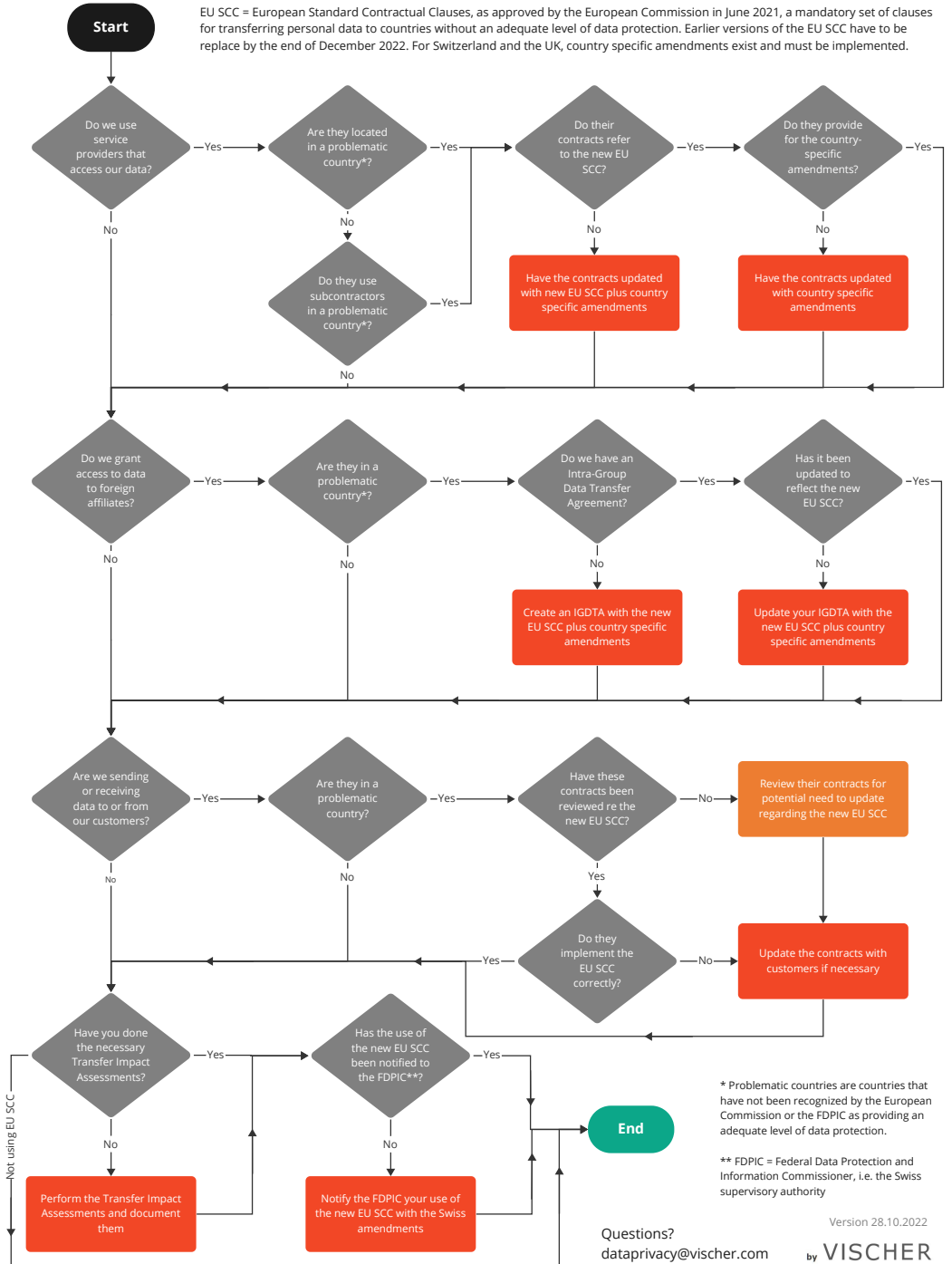


Checking for the need to update existing contracts to properly regulate international data transfers with the new EU SCC .

EU SCC = European Standard Contractual Clauses, as approved by the European Commission in June 2021, a mandatory set of clauses for transferring personal data to countries without an adequate level of data protection. Earlier versions of the EU SCC have to be replaced by the end of December 2022. For Switzerland and the UK, country specific amendments exist and must be implemented.



* Problematic countries are countries that have not been recognized by the European Commission or the FDPIC as providing an adequate level of data protection.

** FDPIC = Federal Data Protection and Information Commissioner, i.e. the Swiss supervisory authority
